

A CLOTHING GRANT FOR YOU AND £1300 FOR YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL

Did you know the council pays a clothing grant of £20 to primary school age children whose family live in North Lincolnshire and get one of these?:

- ▶ Income Support
- ▶ Income-based Job Seekers Allowance
- ▶ Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- ▶ Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- ▶ the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- ▶ Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- ▶ Working Tax Credit run-on – paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- ▶ Universal Credit



You can apply online at www.northlincs.gov.uk (fill in the online form for free school meals), by calling into one of the council's local link offices, by collecting a form from your child's school, or by ringing the council on 01724 297217 for a paper form to be posted to you.

If your child gets a clothing grant, their school gets an extra £1300 from the government every year so it's really important you apply for the clothing grant if you think you qualify for it.
