

The Local Governing Body (LGB) has a key role to play in the governance and accountability framework in the Catholic Multi Academy Trust (CMAT). The LGB is a committee of the CMAT Board of Directors; its role is to understand how the school is being led and managed and to be the 'eyes and ears' of the CMAT Board, monitoring how well the school is progressing.







The LGB is crucial to driving up standards by supporting, challenging and holding the leadership team in the school to account and as such, it has a key role in influencing the development of the school and ensuring that it meets the needs of the children.



Local governors in all schools offer their experience and expertise to strengthen the decision making process and to support the school's journey of continuous improvement. However, within a Catholic school, governors' first responsibility is to ensure that the school is conducted as a Catholic school, to uphold the views and directives of the Bishop of Nottingham and to support his vision for Catholic education in the diocese.
