COVID update

I would like to thank all parents who gave consent for their child to have a Lateral Flow best in school. We identified a very small number of positive cases.

The priority this half term is to preserve face-to-face education for as many students as possible and I wrote to you last Sunday outlining the actions that the school was taking these included:

- The wearing of face coverings in classrooms and communal areas.
- Reducing the number of visitors coming into school.
- Not having mass gatherings of students in one place.

I do therefore ask that where possible you correspond with the school via phone or MS Teams meetings until further notice and do not present yourself at reception unless booked through a prior appointment.

One of the best ways to keep everyone safe is to ensure that your child has two lateral flow tests every week. The school does have a supply of these and students can collect them from student services.

I would also like to outline the current guidance in relation to what to do if your child tests positive for COVID:

- 1. Contact the school at the earliest possible opportunity.
- 2. If you child has symptoms of COVID then book a PCR test.

- 3. From Monday if your child tests positive via a lateral flow test and does not have symptoms they will need to isolate for 10 days from the date of the lateral flow test. Please note even a faint second line should be tested as a positive result.
- 4. If your child is well enough they can take lateral flow tests on day 6 and 7, ideally in the morning. If both are negative then your child can return to school on day 7. If you child is still positive on day 6, they must have negatives on days 7 and 8 and so on.

Consequence system

There has been one change made to the consequence system:

"Students who fail to attend an after-school detention will be placed in our consequences room the following day for periods 4, 5, lunchtime and one hour after school". We will continue to communicate this through the text system.

Remote Learning

Please find attached an instructional document regarding where to find remote learning should your child/children need to isolate and are well enough to continue working. If you have any queries about, please contact your class teachers.

Reports

The Year 7, 9 and 10 reports were issued today on Go 4 Schools. Please can you access Go 4 Schools to read your child's report.
