Isolation

The remaining domestic restrictions in England will be removed. The legal requirement to selfisolate ends on 24 February 2022.

Positive Covid cases

Until 1 April 2022, the government still advises people who test positive to stay at home. Adults and children who test positive should stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least five full days and then continue to follow the guidance until they have received two negative test results on consecutive days. Thereafter they can return to work and normal everyday life.

From April, the Government has stated that it will provide updated guidance setting out the ongoing steps that people with COVID-19 should take to be careful and considerate of others, similar to advice on other infectious diseases. This will align with testing changes.

Yr11 Exams

Year 11 have been given their individual examination timetables for the Summer 2022 series. Please note, this is for GCSE only examinations, and BTEC resits for the May series will not be displayed on this timetable. If an examination has TBA/TBC listed next to it, it means that this is an internally dictated date and will sit in an examination window. Please ensure they keep this safe.
