Year 10 Parents

This year saw the return of exams in formal settings following the pandemic. As a result, we scheduled the year 10 mock exams to take place during the summer term. They are well underway with these and still have further to complete before the end of the year. This will help them to understand the preparation needed to sit a full exam series this time next year. Already, students have commented how labour intensive they find sitting multiple exams in a week and this indicates how seriously they have taken the mocks.

The results from these mocks will be shared with the students and they will review the results with their teachers in class. A copy of the results, along with the predicted grade for the end of year 11, will be sent home to share with parents and carers. We will then invite parents and carers in to discuss the results with teachers and have a focused discussion around what your child needs to do to improve or consolidate their result. This evening will replace the scheduled consultation evening Thursday 14th July and will be in the first half-term of the 22/23 academic year. There will also be an opportunity for a further consultation evening later on in the 22/23 academic year to track and discuss progress made.
