#### **School Lunch**

We operate a cashless till system so all money for lunch should be added through the ParentPay account, We have set for each child a daily allowance allowing students to spends up to £4.50 per day if there are sufficient funds on ParentPay. We have set this value to prevent students spending large amounts each day without the consent of parents, if you wish for your child to have a larger daily allowance please contact the school and we can increase this for individual students.

Free School Meal students have an allowance of £2.60 per day to purchase a Meal Deal at lunch, should your child wish to purchase additional items at lunch or items at break please can you pay additional funds through the ParentPay account to allow for these additional purchases.
