Safeguarding

Misinformation :

Following the tragic incident in July that was subsequently followed by riots we want to raise your awareness to how you can be supported yourselves and also support your adolescents in these times.

The violent unrest seen this summer was fuelled by hateful views and misinformation being spread online.

It's more important than ever that we give young people the knowledge and skills to be able to challenge what they see online.

<u>Educate Against Hate</u> offers an <u>educational programme</u> developed by the Institute of Strategic Dialogue and YouTube which covers topics including:

- How to identify misinformation (e.g. conspiracy theories, clickbait, manipulated media);
- Exploring fact versus opinion, including how sensational content can be used to drive user engagement;
- The benefits and pitfalls of a 'personalised web', including algorithms and filter bubbles;
- Understanding unconscious bias and how it influences our worldview;
- Analysing 'us vs them' narratives, and how online echo chambers may widen social divides;
- Responding effectively to hate speech and forging more inclusive digital communities;
- Creating inspiring digital content o champion causes, promote positive messages and support peers.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Vaccination UK are attending your childs school for the flu vaccinations on Wednesday 8th October. If you would like your child to receive their Nasal flu vaccination in school, please complete a YES online consent form ASAP.

If for any reason your child cannot have the Nasal spray vaccine, the injectable flu vaccine is available, and you will be able to choose that method on the consent form.

If you DO NOT wish your child to receive a flu vaccination, please complete a NO consent via the same link.
