LEVEL 3 - RADIO NETWORK TECHNICIAN

The broad purpose of the apprenticeship is to ensure that digital data and voice networks operate at an optimal level. This is to provide the best possible service to their customers, working as part of a national or regional radio network team. The individual will set up, configure, maintain and monitor radio networks to deliver data services and operate processes for the design, installation, test, implementation, fault finding and optimisation of radio telecoms networks. In their daily work, an employee in this occupation interacts with internal and external customers, owners of potential new cell site locations, equipment suppliers, internal teams, and cross functional leaders.

DEFENCE STEM UNDERGRADUATE SPONSORSHIP (DSUS) - UP TO £42,750

Up to £42,750 (£5k yearly bursary + tuition fees) for students on STEM degree courses commissioning into the Royal Engineers, Royal Signals, Royal Logistic Corps, Royal Electrical and Mechanical Engineers, Royal Artillery, all branches of the Adjutant's General's Corps, Army Air Corps or Intelligence Corps.

NURSING

- OFFICER BURSARY UP TO £42,000

There are two ways to fund your nursing degree: either with an Officer Nursing Bursary, or by studying nursing as a paid Soldier.

You can apply for an Army Officer Nursing Bursary with an unconditional offer to study nursing (at a University of your choice) and you'll receive a £5,000 bursary per year. Upon completion of your initial military training, you will receive a lump sum of £27,000.

This workshop gives students a taste of Army teamwork and problem solving, with a wide range of hands on and confidence building activities that foster the growth of both their mental and physical capabilities.



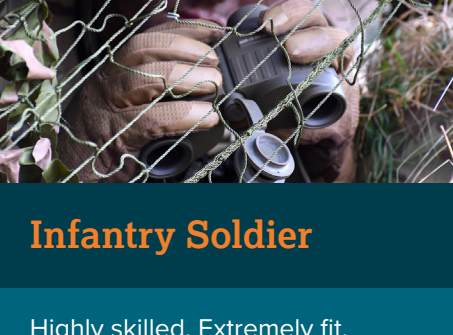
ARMY WORK EXPERIENCE (YEARS' 9+)
