

Tassomai is an online learning platform that helps students strengthen their knowledge through short daily quizzes, It adapts to each child's needs and encourages consistent practice to build confidence and prepare for exams.

How You Can Support Your Child

- Encourage them to use Tassomai for 10-15 minutes a day.
- Praise regular effort - consistency matters more than perfection.
- Ask them what they've learned and check their daily progress on their dashboard.

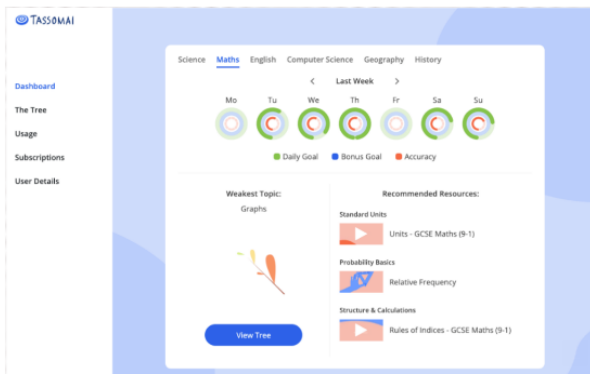
Tassomai is a **personalised, quiz-based learning program**, proven to help students learn and revise – and to get their best possible grades!

It works by encouraging regular 'retrieval practice', **embedding key facts through quizzing**. Tassomai also includes short **explainer videos** and an **AI-powered tutor** to help students if they're stuck.



Your parent account gives you access to a **dashboard** where you can see which **topics your child is doing well in**, and where they might need some extra support.

Accessing the Parent Dashboard



You'll receive an invitation email from Tassomai when your child starts using the platform.

To log in to your dashboard, follow the link in this email and enter your email address. You will then receive a 'password reset' email which will enable you to set yourself a password.

The parent dashboard will show the overview of your child's performance and progress on Tassomai.

Your account also gives you access to your child's **knowledge Tree**, an **interactive representation of their knowledge** in each subject.

Trees grow when a student answers questions on Tassomai.

Weekly progress report emails



These reports summarise your child's activity and engagement from the previous week. These include completion rates, consistency, and accuracy. You may use these reports to celebrate good habits and spot when they might need encouragement.

The link in the email opens your parent dashboard where you'll find more detail on their learning progress.



You will receive a **progress report email** every Monday.

There's also a page on the website with detailed information and a short video for parents whose children use Tassomai.

Top Tips

- Keep Tassomai part of your child's daily routine.
- Make it positive - short bursts work best.
- If you have questions or need help, contact the school for support.

How does Tassomai work?

1. Investigating

Every question answered helps us build up a **detailed knowledge profile**, painting a picture of that child's understanding.

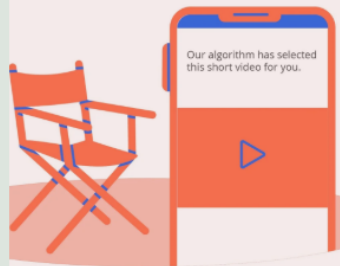


4. Personalising

Sometimes we'll suggest a short **tutorial video** or **link**, offered at just the right time, and designed to supplement learning in a particular topic.



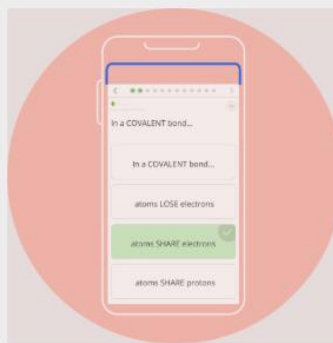
6. Evolving
